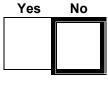

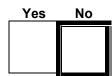
## **Identification**

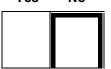
Failure to correctly identity pigs when moved or when identification is not replaced as required is a breach of SMR 6 and requires completion of a breach report

## **Pig Holding Register**

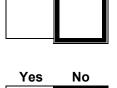
Failure to maintain the mandatory holding register requirements is a breach of SMR 6 and requires completion of a breach report

## **Movement Documents**

- 7 If yes, are you satisfied with the keepers movement document policy (i.e. all mandatory elements of the MD are completed and the MD travels with the Pigs)

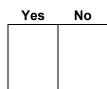
Failure to complete a movement document to accompany a pig movement is NOT a breach of SMR 6 but it is a breach of PRIMO 2011 and requires enforcement action

### Notifications

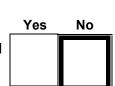
- For ON & OFF moves, are all the movement details in the holding register and the 8 details match the ScotEID print? (if No - update the ScotEID print with ON and OFF movement details and notify SAMU)
- Do all movements on the ScotEID print and all the mandatory information required 9 appear in the holding register?
- 10 Were all movements ON and OFF the holding notified within the legislative deadlines? (for OFF moves notification must take place prior to the move taking place and for ON moves notification must take place within 3 days of their arrival)

Failure to notify pig movements to ScotEID and/or failure to record all mandatory movement information is a breach of SMR 6 and requires completion of a breach report
